University of Alabama astronomer Bill Keel studies galaxies at wavelengths from X-ray to radio. He has been a member of the Galaxy Zoo science team since 2007, harnessing the eyes and brains of thousands of volunteers to find rare and unusually instructive phenomena. He started as a backyard astronomer, and maintains a soft spot for staring into space behind pieces of glass, and went on to study at Vanderbilt and at the University of California. He has written *The Road to Galaxy Formation* and *The Sky at Einstein's Feet*. He sits on the board of the SARA Observatory.
